I am pleased to write this letter of recommendation for Teresa Romero. I have known Teresa for the past five years, first through our working relationship at West Sonoma and Fort Ross Charter Schools, where I was the School Director, and for the past three years at Pathways.

Teresa has worked for me as both class instructor and tutor. While she is skilled in both areas, tutoring is where she shines. This is not simply a matter of basic one-on-one tutoring, mind you. Teresa has managed a group of 12 or more students, each working independently at different levels and with different texts as she moves among them, addressing their individual needs. Each student feels listened to with their needs addressed, even within this larger tutoring setting.
